RE: Harlem Charter School assigning inappropriate sexually explicit erotica to my 12-year-old daughter in Middle School English Class. This is criminal.- PLEASE HELP

Dear Mr. Liu,

William Santiago here. I am writing to you as an extremely angry father.

I am desperately seeking help from you because my underaged child, Cielo Santiago, a 12-year-old girl in 7th grade at Kipps Beyond Middle School, a charter school in Harlem, NYC, is being **assigned** egregiously **explicit, highly-sexualized books** to read in **English class**, as part of the ELA curriculum.

[This is going on against parents wishes, and after 6th months of demanding that the school stop exposing children to this content over parental objections.](#)

I am **attaching excerpts** so that you can see for yourself that the books in question are presenting my 7th grader and her classmates with nothing less than explicit erotica - against parental wishes.

I am also attaching multiple letters to the principal Mr. Negron, and Kipps Schools regional office, starting in October 2023.

The school's insistence on exposing underaged children to this content borders on the criminal, as it clearly constitutes a form of outright sexual abuse, defended by the school under the pretext of educational diversity.

Parents, including myself, are outraged.

But our urgent and unambiguous objections are being met by the school with utter disregard if not contempt for our values, discretion and authority over our children's welfare as their parents.

After six months of countless emails, texts and meetings, with the principal, teachers, the regional office, the school is now insisting on **going forward with assigning another inappropriate, sexually-explicit book** to our child and her classmates.

"Aristotle and Dante Discover the Secrets of the Universe," is the first book my 12-year-old child was assigned to read in 7th grade. The book includes **explicit depictions of masturbation** between two underaged boys and the final **highly sexualized last page where one of the characters trembles with ardent desire while fantasizing of the other boy.**

Moreover, those scenes are just two of the most obviously objectionable highlights woven into a book that should never have been assigned to my child.

"Poet X" is the next book my daughter and her 7th-grade classmates are being assigned. This book includes **multiple sexually explicit encounters of a teenage girl.**

Again these books are being **assigned in class.** They are not merely available at the school, which would be bad enough.

Why is the school so hell-bent on accelerating the sexual maturation of my daughter before she has naturally awakened sexually on her own?! It IS NOT the school's place to make that decision over my clear and repeated objections as Cielo's parent, over my values and judgment as her father.

PLEASE HELP

In any other context, be it at any job, corporate setting, sports league, church, etc., any discussion of such a nature would constitute **sexual harassment, result in immediate firings and lawsuits against the organization.**

But somehow Kipps Beyond Middle School thinks it is proper to impose its will over parental judgment, values and objections to sexually harass my little girl with that same indefensible content.

Cielo's mother and I are frantically exploring other school options for our daughter, as the controversy erupts even further. But finding another appropriate school for Cielo that will accept a middle school transfer in the middle of the year, or even just for 8th grade, is proving complicated and challenging.

I am astonished that this is going on.

I am nauseated that the Kipps Beyond Middle School flagrantly defies parental wishes about assigning these books to underaged children when there are so many other options that would better serve the students' education without sexually harassing them.

This has to stop. Kipps Beyond Middle School and their entire charter system cannot continue to get away with the harm they are doing to children. **Many parents have no idea this is going on.** I didn't until we found out by accident, when Cielo and her friends blurted out comments about what they were reading. Parents were shocked. But many assume there's nothing they can do about it, that this is the new normal.

I won't stand for it. This is wrong. Obviously I want to protect my child. But all children should be protected from this betrayal of trust parents put in their schools.

Please help. As the father of two sweet, smart, beautiful daughters that I dedicate myself to protecting every day, I beg you, please help.

 Good afternoon. Thank you for replying.
I already filed a complaint with the DOE months ago.
They told me to contact the SUNY Charter School Institute.
 I did that - October 6, 2023 (I attached that letter in my original email to you). I'll attach it again here.
 The SUNY Charter School Institute said there is nothing to be done.
 So it seems that the Kipps Beyond Middle school and other charter schools like it, have found a loophole to provide under-aged children (my daughter Cielo is 12 years old) with sexually explicit content, without parental consent, against our protests.
 And nobody wants to help or take responsibility for what is happening.
 If you or the Senator can suggest an effective course of action, I would appreciate that.
 But filing a complaint with the NY State Education Department did not help.
 It's amazing to me that children are left so unprotected from these kinds of things by the educational and political system.
 This is not a matter to be handled like a customer service complaint nuisance and just handed off into the abyss where nothing gets done about it.
 There are many children being harmed.
 So now what?

Good morning Mr. Santiago,

After receiving the response from the SUNY Charter Schools Institute in October of last year, have you proceeded to bring your complaint to the NYS Board of Regents? This is the next step you can take if you believe that the Charter Entity/Authorizer has not adequately addressed your complaint? Below please find the information on how to bring your complaint to the NYS Board of Regents.

Bringing a Complaint to the Board of Regents

If, after first following the complaint process with the School and the School's Charter Entity/Authorizer, you believe that the Charter Entity/Authorizer has not adequately addressed your complaint, you may then bring your complaint to the NYS Board of Regents following the process described below. **Please note that, in the case of schools that are not authorized by the NYS Board of Regents, the law requires that you bring your complaint to the School's board of trustees and then to the Charter Entity/Authorizer before bringing it to the Board of Regents.**

In the case of schools that are authorized by the Board of Regents, you must first bring your complaint to the School's board of trustees and then to the Regents as the Charter Entity following the process described below.

The Board of Regents has delegated the authority to the Commissioner of Education to handle complaints brought to the Regents concerning charter schools. All complaints brought to the Board of Regents/Commissioner concerning charter schools **must be submitted in writing** to the State Education Department's Charter School Office, either via mail at: Charter School Office, NYS Education Department, [89 Washington Avenue, Room 5N Mezz](#), Albany, NY 12234, or via email to: charterschools@nysed.gov (link sends e-mail). The subject line of the email should read: Complaint: [Name of School].

The contents of the letter/email should include:

- A detailed statement of the complaint including the provision of the School's charter or law that you allege has been violated.
- What, if any, response you received from the School's board of trustees (and the School's Charter Entity in the case of schools not authorized by the Board of Regents).
- Copies of all relevant correspondence between you and the School and you and the Charter Entity if applicable. (You should maintain copies of all correspondence and materials for your own files.)
- **What specific action or relief you are seeking.**
- Contact information for you – name, address, email address, telephone number.
